

NEXT SUNDAY IS PALM SUNDAY.

WHY IS THIS SUCH AN IMPORTANT FEAST

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of <u>Holy Week</u>, a solemn week focusing on the final days of Jesus' life. Holy Week culminates on Easter Sunday, the most important

holiday in Christianity.

Jesus traveled to Jerusalem knowing that this journey would end in his <u>sacrificial</u> <u>death</u> on the cross for the <u>sins of all mankind</u>.

The people greeted Jesus enthusiastically, waving <u>palm branches</u> and covering his path with palm branches. The shouts of "Hosanna" meant "save now," and the palm branches symbolized goodness and victory.



The biblical account of Palm Sunday can be found in all four Gospels: Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; and John 12:12-19.


As I was trying to make my Holy Hour, I saw the suffering Jesus, who spoke these words to me: My daughter, do not pay so much
