

GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE: **REJOICE AND BE GLAD!** THE CALL TO HOLINESS

Pope Francis' third and latest apostolic exhortation makes the case for holiness for everyone. With the title drawn from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount (Mt. 5:12), the document was released in early April. In the introduction, the Holy Father

acknowledges that he wants to re-propose

the call to holiness for all in a practical way for our own time, with all its "risks, challenges and opportunities."

GROWING IN HOLINESS, EACH IN HIS OR HER OWN WAY

Through actions great and small, the pontiff says, we can each grow in holiness, encouraging particular attention to the "small gestures" of everyday kindness, patience, prayer and love.

The exhortation, calling on the wisdom of Pope Benedict XVI, states that, "In the end, it is Christ who loves in us; for holiness is nothing other than charity lived to the full."

Pope Francis warns against a faith that is barren, urging us to allow ourselves to be loved by God, guided by the Holy Spirit, and become the "salt of the earth and the light of the world."

GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE IN BRIEF

There are five main themes in the apostolic exhortation:

1. The Call to Holiness is for all. We are each called, in our own way, to grow closer to Christ and to more actively live out his mission through small gestures and great challenges.

2. Subtle enemies of holiness attract us. gnosticism, the lure of intellect above all, and pelagianism, the lure of justification by one's own efforts, are still present today, even though they were decried as heresy in ancient times.

3. The road map to holiness is the beatitudes, in spite of the difficulties of living them out in the modern world. It is important to not separate the Gospel demands from our personal relationship to Christ, or to relativize the social engagement of others.

4. The signs of growth in holiness are perseverance, patience and meekness, joy, a sense of humor, boldness and passion. We grow toward holiness best in community and through constant prayer.

5. The devil is not a myth. Evil is real and prowls among us. We must remain alert, discern carefully and trust in the Lord and in his mercy.
