Jesus Peter, James, & John, go to a mountain (the Mount of Transfiguration) to pray. On the

mountain, Jesus begins to shine with bright rays of light. Then the prophets Moses and Elijah appear next to him and he speaks with them. Jesus is then called "Son" by a voice in the sky, assumed to be God the Father, as in the Baptism of Jesus.

Forbidden to hold services, he and his deacons continued to worship in the chapel in the cemetery of Prætextatus. One day in 258, as the pope preached, soldiers broke into the chapel and beheaded Sixtus.

St. Cajetan was an Italian Catholic priest and religious reformer, co-founder of the Theatines., He is the patron of the unemployed.

He was a Castilian priest and founder of the Dominican Order. Dominic is the patron saint of astronomers.

**Thursday** St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, Virgin & Martyr

On August 9 the Catholic Church remembers St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, also known as St. Edith Stein. St. Teresa converted from Judaism to Catholicism in the course of her work as a philosopher, and later entered the Carmelite Order. She died in the Nazi concentration camp at Auschwitz in 1942.

**Friday** St. Lawrence, Deacon & Martyr

He was one of the seven deacons of the city of Rome, Italy, under Pope Sixtus II who were martyred in the persecution of the Christians that the Roman Emperor Valerian ordered in 258.

St. Clare of Assisi was the first woman to practice the life of entire poverty as taught by St. Francis. Placed by him at

the head of a few companions in the small convent of San Damiano, she governed her community for forty-two years thus founding at the gates of Assisi the Order of Poor Clares

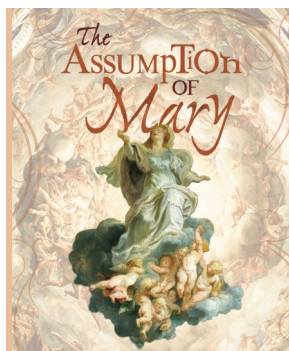

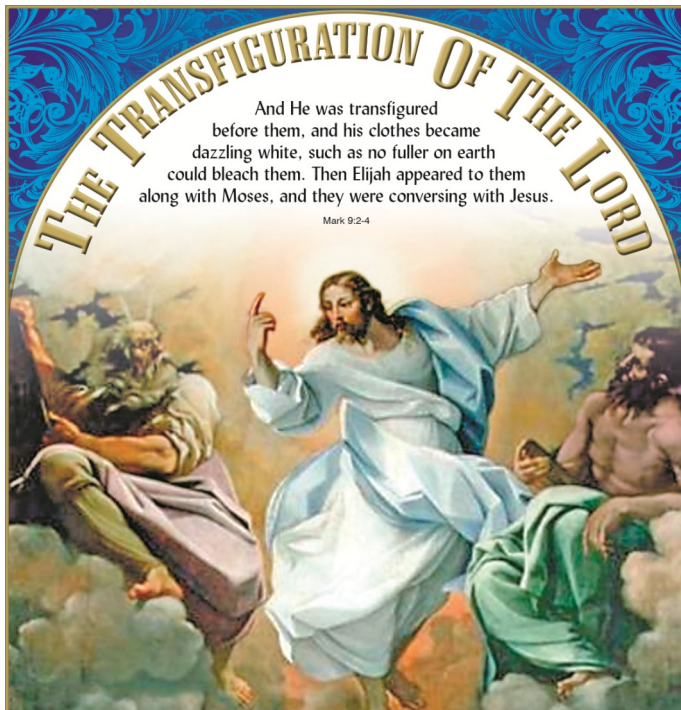
