<b>Sunday</b>	<b>27th Sunday in Ordinary Time</b> Gn 2:18-24; Ps 128:1-6; Heb 2:9-11; Mk 10:2-16 or 10:2-12

<b>Tuesday</b>	<b>St. Denis, Bishop, &amp; Companions, Martyrs; St. John Leonardi, Priest</b>  Gal 1:13-24; Ps 139:1b-3, 13-14ab, 14c-15; Lk 10:38-42 <b>St. Denis</b> was bishop of Paris in the third century and, together with his companions Rusticus and Eleutherius, was martyred for his faith by decapitation. A popular story claims that the decapitated bishop picked up his head and walked several miles while preaching a sermon on repentance & is accounted one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers  <b>St. John</b> Italian Roman Catholic priest and the founder of the Clerks Regular of the Mother of God of Lucca. It was part of the movement known as the Counter-Reformation. Leonardi worked with this group to spread devotion to the Blessed Mother and devotion to the Forty Hours as well as spreading the message of the importance of frequent reception of the Eucharist.

His passionate views on equality were summed up in his statement, "We were all made in God's image, and thus, we are all Godly alike." <sup>1</sup>

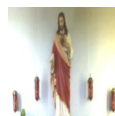

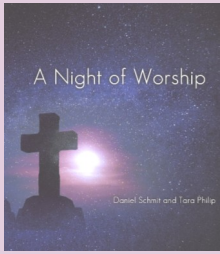

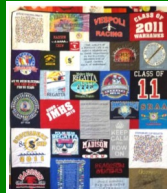
