Monday Saint Teresa of Jesus, Virgin & Church Doctor

 Gal 4:22-24, 26-27, 31—5:1;
 Ps 113:1b-2-7; Lk 11:29-32
 She was a Spanish mystic, Carmelite nun, author, and theologian of contemplative life through mental prayer. Active during the Counter-Reformation, she was a reformer in the Carmelite Order.

Tuesday St. Hedwig, Religious; St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, Virgin

 Gal 5:1-6; Ps 119:41, 43 48
 Lk 11:37-41
Hedwig always helped the poor, the widows and the orphans, founded several hospitals for the sick and the lepers, and donated all her fortune to the Church. She allowed no one to leave her uncomfirmed, and one time she spent ten weeks teaching the Our Father to a poor woman. According to legend, she went barefoot even in winter.

Margaret Mary was a French Roman Catholic Visitation nun and mystic, who promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in its modern form.

Wednesday Saint Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop and Martyr

 Gal 5:18-25; Ps 1:1-2, 3, 4 & 6;
 Lk 11:42-46
 He was an early Christian writer and bishop of Antioch.. En route to Rome, where he met his martyrdom, Ignatius wrote a series of letters. This correspondence now forms a central part of the later collection known as the Apostolic Fathers.

Thursday Saint Luke, Evangelist

 2 Tm 4:10-17b;
 Ps 145:10-11, 12-13, 17-18;
 Lk 10:1-9
 He is one of the Four Evangelists—the four traditionally ascribed authors of the canonical Gospels. The early church fathers ascribed to him authorship of both the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles, which would mean Luke contributed over a quarter of the text of the New Testament, more than any other author.

Friday Sts John de Brébeuf & Isaac Jogues, Priests, Companions, Martyrs
 Eph 1:11-14;
 Ps 33:1-2, 4-5, 12-13; Lk 12:1-7
 French Jesuits were the first missionaries to go to Canada and North America. They were Jesuit missionaries who died as martyrs in North America where they preached the Gospel.

Saturday Saint Paul of the Cross, Priest

 Eph 1:15-23; Ps 8:2-3ab, 4-7;
 Lk 12:8-12
 He was an Italian mystic, and founder of the Passionists. The austerity of life practised by the first Passionists did not encourage large numbers, but Paul preferred a slow, painful, growth to something more spectacular.

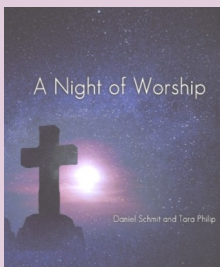

SEEKERS-HOME Parents / Grandparents / Guardians

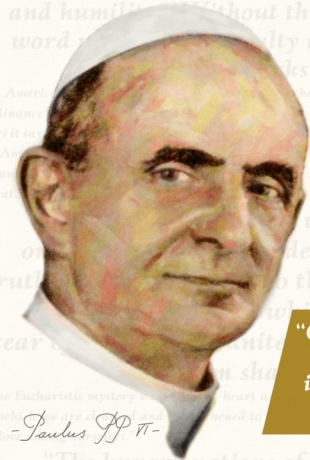

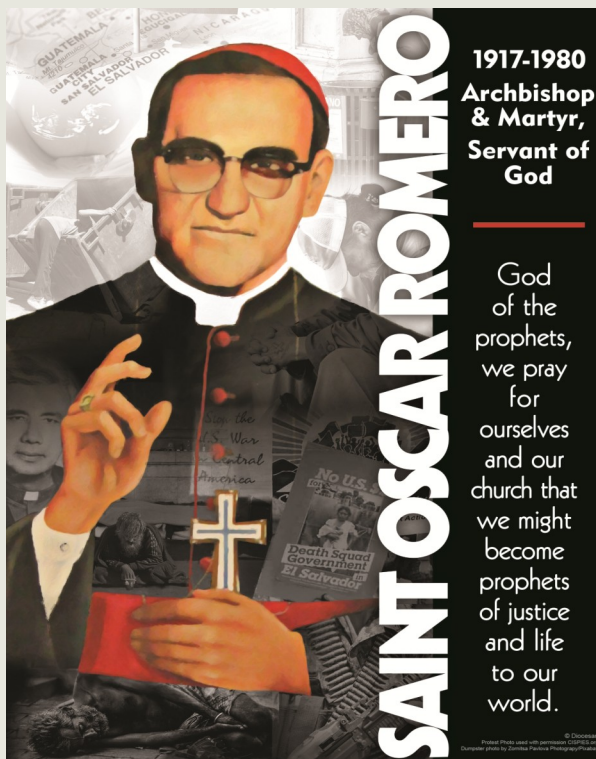
