

He is one of the Four Evangelists—the four traditionally ascribed authors of the

canonical Gospels. The early church fathers ascribed to him authorship of both the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles, which would mean Luke contributed over a quarter of the text of the New Testament, more than any other author.






# SEEKERS-HOME Parents / Grandparents /


