### Thanksgiving Day



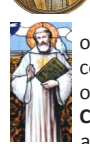

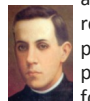

**St. Clement**, Bishop of Rome, holding office from 88 to his death in 99. He is considered to be the first Apostolic Father of the Church.



**Columbanus** taught an Irish monastic rule and penitential practices for those repenting of sins, which emphasised private confession to a priest, followed by penances levied by the priest in reparation for the sins.

**Blessed Miguel** was a fun-loving young Jesuit, & faced the firing squad. He refused a blindfold and asked only for time to pray. He had offered his life for the faith of Mexican people.

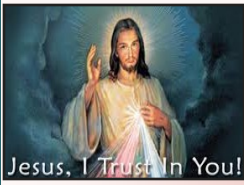
