## Saint John Damascene, Priest & Church Doctor

A polymath whose fields of interest contribution included law, and

theology, philosophy, and music, he is said by some sources to have served as a Chief Administrator to the Muslim caliph of Damascus before his ordination. [ He wrote works expounding the Christian faith, and composed hymns which are still used both liturgically in Eastern Christian practice.

## Saint Ambrose, Bishop & **Church Doctor**

Ambrose was one of the four original Doctors of the Church,

and is the patron saint of Milan. He is notable for his influence on Augustine of Hippo. Traditionally, Ambrose is credited with promoting "antiphonal chant", a style of chanting in which one side of the choir responds alternately to the other.


