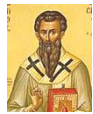

Wednesday **Sts. Basil the Great & Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops & Church Doctors**

Basil was an influential theologian who supported the Nicene Creed & opposed the heresies of the early Christian church. His ability to balance his theological convictions with his political connections made Basil a powerful advocate for the Nicene position.



Gregory made a significant impact on the shape of Trinitarian theology among both Greek- and Latin-speaking theologians, and he is remembered as the "Trinitarian Theologian"

First citizen born in the United States to be given the title of "Saint."



Saturday **St. John Neumann, Bishop**

Neumann spent most of his life building churches, schools, and asylums for his diocese. He was devoted to education and was the first ecclesiastic to organize a diocesan school system in the United States

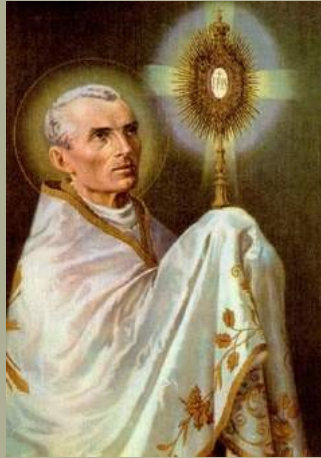

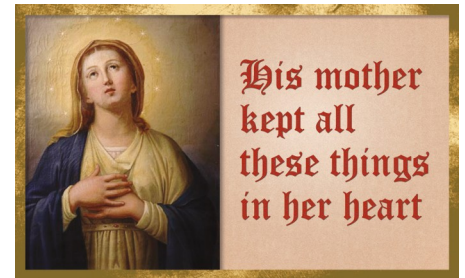

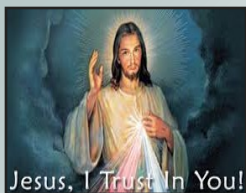
