Thank you for all the hygiene product donations for Catholic Charities as well. It was also great to see 39 ladies coming out for our meeting!

April meeting was again productive and busy. We had an informative presentation from Gerri Lajewski about Catholic Charities' programs, including the warming center, community closet, soup kitchens, and food pantry. She also shared some magazines at the meeting with more information. We had voted in March to donate to GoFundMe for Nate Staley at MSU (Powers student involved in MSU shooting), but as this program had been closed, we chose to redirect the \$250 to Catholic Charities.

Commission reports included information about euthanasia from Right to Life, discussion about "Every Parent Wants to Know" program (sign up www.perfectlyimperfect.org)from Anti-Pornography, and sharing of National CCW human trafficking resources from Anti-Human Trafficking. Discussion was held about Euchre Tournament, Fashion Show, Day Trip, HR Family Fun Day, Fr. Steve's Retirement/Welcome Event for New Priest, Scholarship, Altar Server albs, Audit Committee, and arrangements for May meeting/Mass. The board purchased pinwheels from Voices for Children in recognition of Child Abuse Awareness Month, for members to display in their yards, and we also voted to give our \$100 monthly donation to this cause. We also shared a reminder about upcoming Eucharistic events, which will be listed below. Thank you all for conducting such a great meeting, and I look forward to seeing you all in May. MAY MEETING

Our May meeting will be held on Wednesday May 10th, and will begin with Mass at 5:15 in the church (rosary and May crowning before this at 4:45 led by Our Lady of Fatima Guild). Thank you to everyone who has volunteered to set up and serve at this Mass. We will be having a special ceremony at this Mass to bless all of our new members from the last 2 years. After Mass, we will head over to the Family Life Center for our catered dinner and meeting. Our tangible donation for May will be prize items for the HR Family Fun Day (household knickknacks, candles, puzzles, picture frames, gift cards, etc). We will also have forms available to renew your membership for 2023-24 (vs waiting until the fall), forms are also included with this mailing.

EUCHRE TOURNAMENT

We had another great Euchre Tournament on Thursday April 13th with the Knights of Columbus. We had 12 tables playing, Karen Thornton and Joan Clark served delicious chili and toppings with help from Sylvia Walton, and Natalie Butler made some wonderful cornbread and cookies as well. The Knights provided the drinks and snacks for the event. We split over \$520 in profit. We have decided to proceed with having this as a monthly event, currently scheduled for the 3rd Thursday of the month through the end of the year (not including December). We will continue with a similar format--doors opening at 5:30, game play starting at 6:30, cost \$15 for game play, food, snacks, and door prizes, K of C will also do 50/50. CCW will be responsible for dinner and cookies. We decided on a rotating menu of sloppy joes, pulled pork, "crack" chicken, and chili, each of these will have some kind of side. K of C will provide drinks and snacks, and we will split profits equally. This has been a great event to bring our groups together working on something social for the parish and community. I will bring a list to the May meeting for people to sign up to help with our events from May-August. Next one will be held on May 18th.

FASHION SHOW

CCW Fashion Show will be held on Saturday May 6th at 12:00 in the Family Life Center. Cost for the trip is \$45, which includes transportation, lunch at the shrine, and water/snacks on the bus. For euchre tournament, we plan to run this more simply--no food or door prizes, maybe just some drinks and snacks, try to encourage food vendors to bring things over from the pavilion.

We will be co-sponsoring a pancake breakfast with the Knights of Columbus on Sunday June 25th after the 9AM and 11AM Masses. We plan to provide pastries and fruit and help to hostess. We motioned to cover this expense, and this was tabled to the May meeting for vote. I received an updated cost for the altar server albs that the church has purchased, total cost was \$831.61. This will be on our May agenda for a formal vote.
