

He wrote the book Introduction to the Devout Life (IttDL) nearly 500 years ago, but it doesn't seem a day over 80. Any "lover of God" would be well advised to take a look at this gem of the counter- reformation. Written originally as a series of letters to his 15 year old niece, IttDL is the definitive guide for how to cultivate and maintain a relationship with the Lord. Life-saving blood components can support recovery from injuries or disease. A single blood donation can give one to three patients a better outcome, a chance at survival. Nine out of ten people who live to the age of 70 will use blood during their lifetime."
