## HEART TO HEART: WOMEN'S MINISTRY

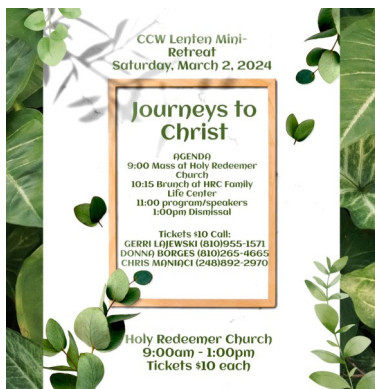

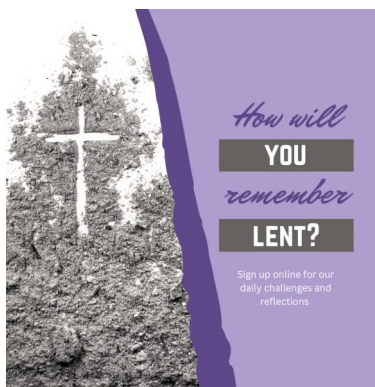


## CCW LENTEN MINI-RETREAT—SAVE THE DATE
