







If you're looking for a way to get connected again, feel free to talk to any of the welcoming Mass attendants or staff! The office is open on the weekends, so stop on by!






HEART TO HEART: WOMEN'S MINISTRY






CCW LENTEN MINI-RETREAT—SAVE THE DATE
