We will be co-hosting a pancake breakfast with the K of C for Fr. Steve's retirement open house on the morning of Sunday June 25th after the 9 and 11 AM Masses. Bidzogo until the fall, as he will not be coming until September 1st.

SCHOLARSHIP

We had 2 applicants for the high school senior scholarship, and made the decision at the meeting to award a scholarship to both applicants, as they were equally qualified. Congratulations to Amelia Bennett and Sean Tucker! There were no applicants for the Pat Paris scholarship. We will try to re-advertise this again in the fall and clarify that the money can be used for continuing education, as well as for returning to school.

ALTAR SERVER ALBS/MONSTRANCE

We had a request in April to cover the cost of new altar server albs, total cost \$831.61. There was a motion made at the April meeting, that was tabled to May, and this motion passed. We also heard a presentation by Sean Groves from the Adoration Chapel requesting funds to help with the cost of replating the monstrance (our monstrance has become pitted and worn, and due to the fact that it has a silver base, it needs to be replated, cost is prohibitive to get a new one). Total cost for this is \$3335--the monstrance has already been sent out for replating, it won't be ready for the re-dedication of the Adoration Chapel but will be back this summer. CCW covered this cost (approximately \$800) in 2004 for the last time it needed replating. There was a motion made to cover the total cost, which was tabled per our bylaws and will be voted on in September. Sean also mentioned that the Adoration Chapel group is looking for more perpetual adorers--if you are interested, there is a form that you can complete on the Holy Redeemer website under the Act tab.

MONTHLY DONATION

Thank you to everyone for the donation of prizes for Family Fun Day. Beth Clark expressed her thanks and was very excited to see all the great items. In honor of Suicide Prevention month, we voted to give our \$100 monthly

donation to support the Genesee County Suicide Hotline. If anyone has ideas for charities needing tangible donations for the upcoming year, please feel free to send me your ideas.

2023-24 BUDGET

Sylvia Walton presented the proposed budget for the 2023-24 year. Several events were noted to have an equal revenue and cost, as these have been events meant to be "fun"raisers, and not necessarily to try to make more money. We have added a line item to the budget for "other altar needs", separate from parish needs, as there are times that we get requests for one-time items for the altar (like the server albs) that we believed should be separated from parish needs, since our primary mission is to care for the altar. We also held discussion about taking some of our money and investing in a 1-year CD to make some more interest. Sylvia will make inquiries to local credit unions in order to get the best rate.

OTHER BUSINESS

Theresa Ballenberger presented on behalf of Laura Fulco about a plaque to be given to Fr. Steve from the CCW in honor of his retirement, being made by some contacts of Laura's. We doubled the size of our ad in the parish bulletin, looks great! Audit committee will be meeting in June to review our books for the past year--thank you to Barb Butler, Kathy Tadajewski, and Donna Borges for volunteering to do this! Maria Brown shared that the annual Regional CCW women's retreat will be held at St. Patrick's in Brighton on September 9th. Gerri Lajewski shared that Wojo's in Davison will be supporting Catholic Charities on May 24th-25th--if you mention Catholic Charities when you make your purchase, a donation will go to them.
