Some will say that they are spiritual and not religious, that they can love Jesus, but hate the Church. How does this view contradict the mission and actions of Jesus himself?

How do the People of God share in the mission of Christ as Priest, Prophet, and King? How does this mission shape the way we live our daily lives as Christians?

Reflect on the following passage from Vatican II:

"Now the laity are called in a special way to make the Church present and operative in those places and circumstances where only through them can it become the salt of the earth. Thus every layman, in virtue of the very gifts bestowed upon him, is at the same time a witness and a living instrument of the mission of the Church itself 'according to the measure of Christ's bestowal."

—Lumen Gentium 33

How can we be the "salt of the earth" and living witnesses to our modern culture? Into whose lives can we bring the good news of the Gospel?
